

545A. GROUP MARKETING OF AUTO INSURANCE TERMINATION PROVISIONS

This endorsement forms a part of the policy to which attached, effective from its date of issue unless otherwise stated herein.

This policy is issued under a Group Marketing Plan authorized under Article 21.77, Texas Insurance Code. The policy General Provision titled "Termination" does not apply and is replaced by the following:

1. This policy may be canceled during the policy periods as follows:
 - a. The named insured shown in the Declarations may cancel by:
 - (1) returning this policy to us; or
 - (2) giving us and the group administrator advance written notice of the date cancellation is to take effect.
 - b. We may cancel this policy only if:
 - (1) you fail to discharge when due any of your obligations in payment of premium; or
 - (2) the insurance for the entire group is canceled.
 - (3) you submit a fraudulent claim.
2. If we cancel the policy for the reasons stated above, we will mail at least 10 days notice to the named insured shown in the Declarations at the address shown in this policy. A copy of the notice will also be mailed to the group administrator.
3. We may not cancel or non-renew a policy based solely on the fact that you are an elected official.
4. We may decide to cancel or not to renew the policies of the entire group. If so, we will mail notice to the group administrator and the named insured at least 30 days before the termination date.
5. Other Termination Provisions.
 - a. We may deliver any notice instead of mailing it. Proof of mailing of any notice shall be sufficient proof of notice.
 - b. If this policy is canceled, you may be entitled to a premium refund. If so, we will send you the refund promptly. The premium refund, if any, will be computed according to the Cancellation Rule of the Texas Department of Insurance. However, making or offering to make the refund is not a condition of cancellation.
 - c. The effective date of cancellation stated in the notice shall become the end of the policy period.
